

NOTICE

Sr. Divisional Commercial Manager, Northern Railway, Firozpur for and on behalf of President of India invites applications for setting up stall/kiosk at all Railway Stations over Firozpur Division under **One Station One Product scheme**. OSOP stalls will be operational w.ef. **24.04.2023**. The terms and conditions are as under :

1. The minimum period for setting up of the stall/kiosk will be 15 days.
2. Details of token fee to be deposited by the applicants is as under:-

S.No	Category	Total Token fee for 15 days (in Rs.)
1	For NSG 1 to NSG-4 Stations	1000/-
2	For NSG-5 to NSG-6 Stations	500/-

All above charges are inclusive of GST.

3. Product to be displayed/sold as under:

(i) **Handicrafts/Artefacts**

(ii) **Textiles and Handlooms**

(iii) **Traditional Garments**

(iv) **Local agricultural produce/ processed/semi processed foods.**

4. The selection of participants in the OSOP may be done considering that the benefit of this scheme must reach the marginalized sections, i.e. those individuals at the bottom of the pyramid. Priority shall be given to the following:

(a) Holder of Artisan/Weaver ID card issued by Development Commissioner Handicrafts, Development Commissioner Handloom, or by the requisite State/Central Government Authority.

(b) Individual artisans/weavers/craftsmen enrolled/registered with Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India Limited (TRIFED)/National Handloom Development Corporation (NHDC)/Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) etc.

(c) Self Help Groups registered with PMEGP (Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme).

(d) Marginalized or weaker sections of society.

5. The applicant will have to submit an undertaking to the Station Superintendent indicating that no activity would be undertaken to adversely affect the train operations, passenger safety and image of the Railways.
6. Application should be addressed and can be submitted to Station Superintendent at Station by the applicant.
7. Station Superintendent will make priority roster of all approved participants and priority will be established through a draw of lots conducted at the Station in the presence of all approved applicants by the Station Manager/ Sectional CMI.
8. Space and infrastructure at the station for this scheme will be provided by Railways.
9. For any queries applicant may contact Station Superintendent or CMI of the respective stations.
