

NOTICE

Sr. Divisional Commercial Manager, Northern Railway, Firozpur for and on behalf of President of India invites applications for setting up stall/kiosk at all Railway Stations over Firozpur Division under **One Station One Product scheme**. This scheme was started from April, 2022 in this Division. The terms and conditions are as under:

1. The period for setting up of the stall/kiosk will be 45 days. In such cases, registration fee and electricity charges shall increase proportionately. It is a continuous process.
2. Details of token fee to be deposited by the applicants is as under:-

S. No.	Category	Total Registration/Token fee for 45 days (in Rs.)
1	For NSG-1 to NSG-4 Stations	3,000/-
2	For NSG-5 to NSG-6 Stations	1,500/-

All above charges are inclusive of GST.

3. Product to be displayed/sold as under:

- (i) Handicrafts/Artefacts
 - (ii) Textiles and Handlooms
 - (iii) Traditional Garments
 - (iv) Local agricultural produce/processed/semi processed foods.
4. The selection of participants in the OSOP may be done considering that the benefit of this scheme must reach the marginalized sections, i.e. those individuals at the bottom of the pyramid. Priority shall be given to the following:
 - (a) Holder of Artisan/Weaver ID card issued by Development Commissioner Handicrafts, Development Commissioner Handloom, or by the requisite State/Central Government Authority.
 - (b) Individual artisans/weavers/craftsmen enrolled/registered with Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India Limited (TRIFED)/National Handloom Development Corporation (NHDC)/Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) etc.
 - (c) Self Help Groups registered with PMEGP (Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme)
 - (d) Marginalized or weaker sections of society.
 5. The applicant will have to submit an undertaking to the Station Superintendent indicating that no activity would be undertaken to adversely affect the train operations, passenger safety and image of the Railways.
 6. Application should be addressed and can be submitted to Station Superintendent at Station by the applicant.
 7. A maximum of 20 units of electricity per OSOP outlet shall be permitted for one spell of 15 days as basic facilitation subsumed in the registration charges. For additional units of electricity over and above the limit of 20 units, the applicable charges shall apply on actual basis.
 8. Station Superintendent will make priority roster of all approved participants and priority will be established through a draw of lots conducted at the Station in the presence of all approved applicants by the Station Manager/Sectional CMI.
 9. Space and infrastructure at the station for this scheme will be provided by Railways.
 10. For any queries applicant may contact Station Superintendent/Sectional CMI of the respective stations.
